Art and Craft Vendor Requirements

- Electricity (110v) is offered to vendors for an additional \$10
- New art or craft vendors must include a list of previous events, references and photos with their application
- Manufactured goods, kits or imports will not be accepted
- Vendors must arrive one hour prior to the opening of the festival for set up
- Vendors are required to stay the entire length of the festival
- Booths must be staffed at all times
- Vendors must provide their own tables, chairs and cover
- All applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis and go through a juried process conducted by the Festival Committee. You will be notified upon approval
